STATE OF THE NATION

Bill John Baker Principal Chief

> Chief Baker announced they have rolled out the economic impact statement for the Cherokee Nation showing where money is spent county by county. The distribution of checks totaling over \$3ml were given to the schools on President's Day. CNB has recently signed a \$5.7ml contract for design and renovation at Dover Air Force Base, CRC has signed a \$1.6ml contract with Dover AFB, Red Wing has just signed a \$18.4ml and a \$20ml contract to provide nonstandard materials and services to the Army. He recognized two of our EMT's were received honors at the Annual National Native American Medical Services Association Conference. We hosted the Cherokee Nation Science Fair at NSU which had ninety-six entries from seven schools across the fourteen counties. He recognized two of the science fair winners who will represent the Cherokee Nation at the National Contest in May. Free and open to the public beginning Cherokee language classes are scheduled to start next month in eight counties. He requested a moment of silence for those Cherokee citizens whom we have lost over the last month. Veterans honored for the month of February were brothers James Carl Warrington and Lindsay Eugene Warrington also recognized was Curtis G. Johnson.

Monthly Reports:

Housing Authority - David Southerland

Mr. Southerland announced they are gearing up for new construction. They have mailed letters to families that are on the self-help home waiting list and the vacant mutual help home waiting list to offer them the new program first. They will begin taking applications in the near future from everyone else. A decision needs to be made soon in regard to the number of applications to be taken per year. They have begun constructing the three model homes which will be used as office space once complete. He encouraged everyone to stop by and look at the homes. There will be sixteen contracts awarded on the model homes, twelve of which will be awarded to TERO vendors. The Housing Authority will serve as the general contractor of the model homes. The premiums for the Community Shield homeowners coverage have gone up \$1 per year.

Cherokee Nation Business, Inc - David Stewart

Mr. Stewart reported the financial results are very strong. The net income is at \$11.5ml which is 5% above budget. Their projects are on schedule and the expansion at the Hard Rock is being funded with cash.
