### AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #29-10 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011 - MOD 10; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

#### SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as “**An Act Amending Legislative Act #29-10 Authorizing the Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2011 - Mod. 10**”.

#### SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the “Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2011” or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by **\$1,111,108** for a total budget authority of **\$657,319,542**. The following items are identified as selective General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

#### SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #21-09 are applicable to this amendment.

#### **SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS**

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of **\$491,232** to wit:

- A. A net increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of **\$7,021**, related to the tribal election fund, Inauguration, and the Cherokee Publications, as well as cash match requirements of the Nowata Elder Nutrition Building.
- B. An increase in the **Indirect Cost Pool** budget authority of **\$27,209** related to the Cherokee Publications budget.
- C. An increase in the **HUD Fund** budget authority of **\$331,500** related to current year construction costs of the Nowata Elder Nutrition Building.
- D. An increase in the **NAHASDA Fund** budget authority of **\$63,201** related to additional revenues in the Housing Management program.
- E. An increase in the **Special Revenue Other Fund** budget authority of **\$62,301** related to the JOM Conference Special Register.
- F. A reallocation within the **Capital Projects Fund** budget authority resulting in a net impact of **\$0** related to the Salina Dental Clinic and the Physical Therapy center at Hastings.

#### **SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE**

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

#### **SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY**

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

#### **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED**

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

#### **SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS**

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.
