LEGISLATIVE ACT 17-18

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #26-17 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 – Mod. 10; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #26-17 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2018 – Mod. 10".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2018" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$29,799,043 for a total budget authority of \$724,758,390. The following items are identified as components of such change:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #26-17 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of § 29,872,957 to wit:

- A. An increase in the General Fund budget authority of § 312,725.
- B. An increase in the DOI PL 102-477 budget authority of § 8,229.
- C. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of \$ 388,958.
- D. An increase in the IHS Self Governance Health budget authority of \$ 24,622,872.

- E. An increase in the IHS Self Governance TEH budget authority of \$4,510,173.
- F. An increase in the **Special Revenue Other** budget authority of \$30,000.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

- 1. <u>Cultural Resources 1010046 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$14,390 based on a CNB donation for the purchase of bikes for the Remember the Removal Bike Ride. The new expenditure total is \$303,119.
- 2. <u>Cultural Outreach 1010210 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$100 based on a cash donation for the duplication of Rosebud Seminary CD by Barbara McAlister's students. The new expenditure total is \$500.100.
- 3. <u>Cherokee Charter School 1010211 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$500 based on a cash donation related to the 5th grade performance at the InterTribal

- Language Conference. The new expenditure total is \$2,317,279 with the net expenditure total remaining at \$2,316,779.
- 4. Cherokee National Youth Choir 1010217 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$12,139 based on a CNB donation for 50% of the Youth Choir to travel to the Cherokee Days in DC. The new expenditure total is \$192,139 with the net expenditure total remaining at \$170,000.
- 5. <u>Cash Match For Grants 1010315 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$75,000 by reducing the amount appropriated for future cash matches to provide funding for Human Services Emergency Assistance it item 7. The new balance appropriated (reserved) for cash match is \$518,840 as shown in the Grant Reporting section above.
- 6. <u>Community Water & Sewer -- 1010432 -- General Fund:</u> Modification requesting a change in expenditure authorization to allow a \$296,000 transfer to EHS Projects in item 24. The new expenditure total remains at \$1,329,105.
- 7. <u>Human Services Emergency Assistance 1010461 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$75,000 for direct client services and emergency assistance. Funding is made available by the reduction in the reserve for cash match in item 5. The new expenditure total is \$250,750.
- 8. <u>Supreme Court 1010800 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$11,020 to incorporated funds received from the Cherokee Nation Bar Association (CNBA) annual dues. The new expenditure total is \$615,141 with the net expenditure total remaining at \$598,121.
- 9. <u>District Court 1010805 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$13,000 based on a revised estimate of other income from filing fees. The new expenditure total is \$478,308 with the net expenditure total remaining at \$415,308.
- 10. <u>Tribal Leases Realty 1012290 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$191,660 based on revenue received from a right way easement renewal from Phillips 66. The new expenditure total is \$316,660 with the net expenditure total remaining at \$0.
- 11. <u>Land Development Land Ops 1012350 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$69,916 based on estimated increase in property rental and other income. The new expenditure total is \$1,163,582 with the net expenditure total remaining at \$471,278.
- 12. <u>SG General Assistance 3222220 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$388,958 for client services based an estimate through the end of the fiscal year. Funding is provided by DOI SG carryover. The new expenditure total is \$1,367,389.
- 13. PL 102-477 Career Services 3231100 DOI PL 102-477: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$8,229 based on additional grant funds received. The new expenditure total is \$5,636,220.
- 14. <u>Stilwell Revenue 3322105 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$380,960 for contract services, supplies, and equipment lease. Funding is provided by increased estimates for third-party and small decreased estimate in IHS revenue required. The new expenditure total is \$12,666,410.
- 15. <u>Sallisaw Revenue 3322205 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$905,209 for contract services, supplies on agreement, and utilities. Funding is provided by increased estimates for third-party and decreased estimate in IHS revenue required. The new expenditure total is \$11,606,607.

- 16. <u>Jay Revenue 3322305 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$511,039 for supplies on agreement, utilities and property insurance. Funding is provided by slight decreased estimates for third-party and increased estimate in IHS revenue required. The new expenditure total is \$10,035,338.
- 17. <u>Salina Revenue 3322405 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$287,971 for supplies on agreement and utilities. Funding is provided by decreased estimates for third-party and increased estimate in IHS revenue required. The new expenditure total is \$9,835,613.
- 18. Nowata Revenue 3322505 IHS Self Governance Health: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$257,868 for several contract and supply accounts. Funding is provided by increased estimates for third-party revenue. The new expenditure total is \$6,331,042.
- 19. Ochelata Revenue 3322705 IHS Self Governance Health: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$320,347 for contract services, locum tenens, and supplies. Funding is provided by increased estimates for third-party revenue. The new expenditure total is \$4,705,513.
- 20. <u>Vinita Revenue 3322805 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$836,884 for supplies and utilities. Funding is provided by increased estimates for third-party and decreased estimate in IHS revenue required. The new expenditure total is \$10,950,342.
- 21. <u>Hastings Revenue 3323005 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$8,335,167 for contract services, locum tenens, supplies, and utilities. Funding is provided by increased estimates for third-party and small decreased estimate in IHS revenue required. The new expenditure total is \$107,691,592.
- 22. Pharmacy Refill Center 3325700 IHS Self Governance Health: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$1,748,581 for supplies on agreement. Funding is provided by increased IHS funding required. Note all third-party funding received for prescriptions go to the facility generating the prescription. The new expenditure total is \$14,209,938.
- 23. <u>Health Equipment Replacement 3329030 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$11,038,846 including a \$8,000,000 transfer out to the capital budget Health Facilities Equipment that is shown in this month's capital budget mod. Funding is provided by IHS Self Governance carryover. The new expenditure total is \$13,538,846.
- 24. <u>EHS Projects 3332000 IHS Self Governance TEH:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$4,510,173 for new 2018 IHS project funding. The new expenditure total is \$11,449,692.
- 25. <u>IGNITE Language Conference 3901820 Special Revenue Other:</u> New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$30,000 that is budgeted to be fully funded by registration fees.
