

An Act

LEGISLATIVE ACT 15-08

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #37-07 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008 – Mod. 9; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as “**An Act Amending Legislative Act #37-07 Authorizing the Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2008 – Mod. 9**”.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the “Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2008” or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$1,137,445 for a total budget authority of \$471,947,532. The following items are identified as estimated General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #37-07 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This amendment changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by a net increase of \$1,137,445 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of \$304,192 primarily related to a program subsidy in the Housing Accessibility program and the SHS Multipurpose Center.
- B. An increase in the **Motor Fuels Tax Fund** budget authority of \$215,000 related to additional funding for the minor emergency repair program and a reallocation of scholarship funding.

- C. A transfer into the **Tribal Force Account** to close out the books on the former equipment replacement budget.
- D. An increase in the **Enterprise Fund** budget authority of **\$9,384** related prior year unexpended funds.
- E. A net increase in the **DOI-Self Governance** budget authority of **\$283,316** with the increase primarily related to the Delaware Tribe agreement as well the Indian Child Welfare program, slightly offset by a decrease on the Tar Creek project.
- F. A decrease in the **NAHASDA Fund** budget authority of **<\$150,000>** to remove a cash match transfer related to the Community Planning program.
- G. An increase in the **Capital Projects Fund** budget authority of **\$475,553** to authorize the close-out and residual fund balance transfer of the SHS Multipurpose Center, to the General Fund.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

A. JUNE - GRANTS RECEIVED (REPORTING ONLY):

B. MOD - 9 (15 budgets) Net Increase in budget authority - \$852,009:

General Fund: (Increase - \$296,623) + 7569 = \$304,192

+ 7569 = \$304,192
= \$1,440

(1): General Fund Operations: Requesting an increase of \$14,722 to transfer necessary funding to item #10 below, covering the cumulative net deficit from prior years and close out the accounting unit. This budget is also recognizing a transfer-in related to the residual fund balance in the capital project fund of the SHS Gym. The transfer amount increasing the available funds for appropriation is \$515,553. Of this transfer amount, \$308,733 is paying back the General Fund for expenses it recorded in FY04.

(2): Cash Match for Grants: Requesting to reallocate and transfer a 50/50 cash match of \$150,000 to the USDA Community Planning program. These matching funds were previously provided by the "Community Planning" budget of the NAHASDA block grant (see item #14 below).

(3): Housing Accessibility Program: Requesting a \$200,000 increase in the current year budget from \$400,000 to \$600,000. This budget, as of this date, has over-obligated its spending authority by \$176,486 and of that, over expended its authority by \$145,879. In summary, nearly 90% of this additional funding request is already obligated or expended.

(4): Old Homeland Building: Requesting a budget increase of \$11,198 to pay off the remaining note balance on this property in this current fiscal year.

(5): Facet Industrial Building: Also requesting a budget increase of \$30,703 to pay off the remaining note balance in the current fiscal year. The interest rate on this note is 7.625%.

(6): SHS Multi-Purpose Center (New Budget): Requesting \$40,000 for the artwork in the center. These funds were originally part of the capital projects fund that is transferring \$515k back into the General Fund. (see items #1 & #15)

Motor Fuels Tax Fund: (Increase - \$215,000)

(7): Minor Emergency Repair: Requesting additional carryover of \$140,000 from prior years balances.

(8 & 9): Higher Education & Voc-Ed Scholarships: Requesting a \$75,000 reallocation and transfer from the Higher Education Scholarship program over to the Voc-Ed Scholarship program.

Tribal Force Account: (Close-Out - Transfer In)

(10): Equipment Replacement/Repair: Requesting to recognize a transfer in from the General Fund for the cumulative net deficit from prior years and close out the accounting unit (see item #1 above).

Enterprise Fund: (Increase - \$9,384)

(11): CDFI Fund: Requesting spending authority on \$9,384 of prior year carryover for staff development and training.

DOI – Self Governance Fund: (Net Increase - \$5,449)

(12): Tar Creek: Recognizing an adjustment of <\$14,551> to the previously anticipated carryover balance from the prior year.

(13): Indian Child Welfare: Requesting an increase in spending authority of \$20,000 due to IVE income received this fiscal year to date.

NAHASDA Fund: (Decrease - <\$150,000>)

(14): 2006 IHP Community Planning: Requesting to shift the USDA Community Planning cash match transfer of \$150,000, from this block grant over to the General Fund (see item #2 above). This budget removal should avail this \$150,000 for other housing appropriation needs; however, no request was submitted to utilize these funds. A consideration could be to review the possibility of utilizing these housing dollars to offset the tribal funding requested in item #3 above for the Housing Accessibility program. This will retain more discretionary dollars for future needs.

Capital Projects Fund: (Increase - \$475,553)

(15): SHS Multipurpose Center: Requesting authority to transfer the remaining residual fund balance of the Gym and close-out the project over to the General Fund (related to items #1 & #6 above).


C. COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE, CEMETERIES & LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNDS:
