**RESOLUTION NO. 64-24**

**COUNCIL OF THE CHEROKEE NATION**

**A RESOLUTION ELECTING JOHNNY KIDWELL, A MEMBER OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL, TO THE OFFICE OF SECRETARY OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government in behalf of the Cherokee people; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Rules of Procedure of the Cherokee Nation Tribal Council provides for the Office of Secretary of the Tribal Council with duties to attest to all legislation of the Council and maintain the records and journals of the Council; and,

**WHEREAS**, this office is elected annually from the membership of the Tribal Council; and,


**WHEREAS**, Title 19 Section 32 of the Cherokee Code provides for the Office of Secretary of the Council; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Secretary of the Council is to be a member of high qualification and experience capable of performing the duties of the office with fidelity;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Cherokee Nation through its Tribal Council, that Johnny Kidwell be elected as Secretary of the Council for the term beginning November 2024 to November 2025.

**CERTIFICATION**


