# APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Cobb moved to approve the February 14th regular session minutes. Councilor Cowan Watts seconded the motion. The motion carried.

#### REPORTS:

1. Management Resources - Angela Drewes

Ms. Paula Ragsdale offered to answer questions from the Management Resources report. Councilor Crittenden inquired about the possibility of the Nation working with the State and cities with regard to some of the parks the State is scheduling to close. Ms. Ragsdale stated discussion was held this morning in this regard. Councilor Fullbright announced they would be hosting a public forum at Blue Ribbon Downs in the conference room on March 29th at 6:00 p.m. in regard to the Sallisaw State Park. Councilor Buzzard requested follow-up on the rumor of additional chicken houses

being built on Leach road. He also inquired as to who does the inspections on the lease for the Restaurant of the Cherokees and other restaurants on within our entities properties.

2. Real Estate Services - Linda Donelson

Ms. Donelson announced the grazing lease cycle is coming up and they will be adding a lessee preference. This will allow a current lessee to keep the tract if their bid is within 10% of the highest bid. The current lessee would have to match the bid, be in compliance on their lease and be in good standing. The bid packets will go out this week for eighty-two tracts. The bid opening will be at 1:00 p.m. on the 28th of April. Ms. Donelson requested Councilor Cowan Watts be added as sponsor to the trust tract resolution for the Collinsville property and to add Councilor Crittenden for the Roland property. Councilor Fullbright requested to added as a sponsor to the Roland property resolution.
