LEGISLATIVE ACT 19-24

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #22-23 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 - Mod. 8 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #22-23 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2024 – Mod. 8".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2024" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$3,775,878 for a total budget authority of \$3,112,834,847. The following items are identified as components of such change:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #22-23 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by a decrease of \$874,062 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **Tribally Funded** budget authority of \$ 29,500.
- B. An increase in the IHS Self Governance Health budget authority of \$844,562.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void, the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

 Tribal Youth Council – 10102300 – Tribally Funded: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$29,500 for historical education trip to Cherokee, NC. Funding provided by CNB donation. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$63,600 with the net expenditure remaining at \$34,100.

- 2. <u>Unappropriated Reserve 10102960 Tribally Funded:</u> Modification requesting a decrease of \$ (780,000) in reserved by appropriation to provide the funding for the Clothing For Kids budget in item 3. The new reserved by appropriation total is \$5,850,598.
- 3. <u>Clothing For Kids 10104580 Tribally Funded:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$780,000. See the budget narrative for changes in funding and goals. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$1,050,000.
- 4. <u>Ambulance Service 33241000 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$844,562 to budget carryover funds. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$8,954,435.
