

# An Act

## **LEGISLATIVE ACT 26-08**

### **AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #19-08 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009 – Mod. 1; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:**

#### **SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION**

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as “An Act Amending Legislative Act #19-08 Authorizing the Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2009 – Mod. 1”.

#### **SECTION 2. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the “Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2009” or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$5,534,221 for a total budget authority of \$485,579,150. The following items are identified as estimated General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

#### **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #19-08 are applicable to this amendment.

#### **SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS**

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This amendment changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by a net increase of \$5,534,221 to wit:

- A. A net increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of \$12,000 primarily related to the Cherokee Historical Society, Immersion Projects, Land Operations and grant cash matches.
- B. A net increase in the **IDC Fund** budget authority of \$68,395 for an increase in the TERO budget as well as a reallocation of resources related to the Hastings Resource Team.

- C. An increase in the **Enterprise Fund** budget authority of **\$538,700** related to the Intermediary Relending Program.
- D. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance Fund** budget authority of **\$85,000** related to a new Energy and Mineral Development Grant.
- E. An increase in the **IHS Self Governance – Health Fund** budget authority of **\$3,515,116** to authorize the prior year funding for Health Equipment Replacement fund.
- F. An increase in the **NAHASDA Fund** budget authority of **\$172,510** related to the '04 Indian Housing Plan for new construction projects.
- G. An increase in the **E.P.A. Fund** budget authority of **\$124,800** related to a Brownsfield grant for the Saline Courthouse.
- H. An increase in the **Federal Other** budget authority of **\$1,017,700** pursuant to a transfer to the Intermediary Loan Fund.

## **SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE**

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

## **SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY**

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

## **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED**

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

## **SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS**

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.



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Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

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### A. OCTOBER - GRANTS RECEIVED (REPORTING ONLY):

### B. MOD – 1 (24 budgets) Net Increase in budget authority - \$5,524,221: + \$10,000

#### General Fund: (Net Increase - \$2,000)

Natural Resources  
Ga-Du-Gi Project  
(Fuel Costs)

- (1): Human Service – Deputy Group Leader: Requesting a shift of **\$137,812** of this group's succession planning funds to be moved into this budget out of the Succession Planning budget below (see item #4).
- (2): Cherokee Immersion Projects: Requesting to remove the revenue of **<\$9,000>** along with the transfer of 1 employee to another budget; partially offset by an increase in space cost, resulting in a net decrease of **<\$18,000>**.
- (3): CN Historical Society: Requesting additional funding **\$20,000** funding for a beadwork exhibit.
- (4): Succession Planning: Reducing this budget by the **<\$137,812>** amount shifted to item #1 above.
- (5): Cash Match for Grants: Requesting a reallocation of funds to provide a cash match for the Brownsfield funded grant for the Saline Courthouse (see item #24 below).

### Indirect Cost Pool: (Net Increase - \$68,395)

(12): T.E.R.O. Procurement: Requesting a \$68,395 increase in salary/fringe to this budget.

*Note: This staffing increase is related to an employee # that is already budgeted elsewhere in the FY09 budget; however, the other budget this employee # appears on is not requesting a corresponding decrease. I would recommend this budget be allowed to proceed and the Committee request the Financial Resource Group solicit the appropriate budget adjustments for next month's budget mod for the 1010530 and 1010531 budgets.*

(Items 6,7,9,10,11,14): The following items are reallocating the Hastings Resource Team budget and a portion of the HR Recruiting budget to various budgets. This reallocation is pursuant to further identifying specific disciplines associated with the support functions surrounding the assumption of Hastings.

(6): <u>Office of Attorney General:</u>	\$79,178	Increase (1 FTE + associated costs)
(7): <u>Human Resources:</u>	\$288,583	Increase (5 FTE/MOA/IPA's + associated costs)
(9): <u>Financial Resources:</u>	\$76,290	Increase (1 FTE + associated costs)
(10): <u>Information Systems - IDC:</u>	\$1,268,009	Increase (10 FTE/MOA/IPA's + associated costs)
(11): <u>Acquisition Management:</u>	\$193,393	Increase (3 FTE/MOA/IPA's + associated costs)
(14): <u>Resource Team Hastings:</u>	<\$1,905,453>	Decrease (20 FTE/MOA/IPA's & associated costs)
Net Reallocation	\$0	

(8 and13): Reallocating \$211,691 from the HR Recruitment budget into the Health Executive Director IDC's budget. These costs represent the costs associated with 1 health recruiter and associated costs plus \$100,000 line item for "recruitment". This funding shift to Health represents approximately ½ of the total Recruiting budget for the Nation.

### Enterprise Fund: (Increase - \$538,700)

(15): Intermediary Relending Program: Requesting authorization to transfer **\$517,700** of prior year unobligated funds to the Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI) grant (see item #24 below). These funds will be matched with a grant on that budget and collectively be transferred into the CDFI Loan Fund below.

(16): 2008 CDFI Loan Pool: Requesting to receive \$1,017,000 of transferred funds from item #24, as previously mentioned, to administer the loan program as **\$21,000** of expenditure authority related to bad debts and other costs.

### D.O.I. – Self Governance: (Increase - \$85,000)

(17): Energy and Mineral Development: Requesting spending authority on an \$85,000 DOI grant awarded in May of 2008 pursuant to the self-governance compact.

### I.H.S. – Self Governance Health: (Net Increase - \$3,515,116)

(18 thru 20): Contract Health and Health Facilities: Are requesting increased spending authority of **\$28,078** and **\$63,940** respectively related to a funding shift those amounts in aggregate of <\$92,018> from the Health Group Leader's budget. These shifts of funds are related to 2-FTE and their associated costs.

(21): Health Equipment Replacement: Requesting authority to spend FY07 funding that was still unspent during FY08 in the amount of **\$3,515,116**.

### NAHASDA Fund: (Increase - \$172,510)

(22): 2004 IHP C/S New Construction: Requesting spending authority of **\$172,510** of funds from the FY04 IHP for New Construction to close out these funds.

**E.P.A. Fund: (Increase - \$124,800)**

(23): BF Saline Courthouse: Requesting \$124,800 of spending authority from a Brownsfield grant of **\$104,000** and **\$20,800** of matching funds (see item #5 above) for the Saline Courthouse.

**Federal –Other Funding: (Increase - \$1,017,700)**

(24): 2008 Comm. Dev. Financial Institution Fund: Receiving \$517,700 from the Intermediary Relending Program (item #15) and matching that with an additional \$500,000 of CDFI grant funds and then transfer that **\$1,017,700** to the accounting unit administering the loans; the CDFI Loan Pool (item #16 above).

**C. COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE, LAW ENFORCEMENT & CEMETERIES FUNDS:**

The attached lists of projects have been approved, or are being requested to be approved in this Executive/Finance Committee. These projects have already been appropriated; therefore, there is no need to appropriate the funds again. This list is for informational purposes and is included within this mod package review for inclusion purposes.

**Summary:**

After reviewing the submission of Mod-1, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests and nor do I have any concerns related to their respective carryover estimates.
