## REPORTS:

Marshal Service - Shannon Buhl

Marsha Buhl reported on their part in the double homicide in Tahlequah last week. They are currently in the field removing remains from a well. He offered to answer questions from the report.

Office of the Attorney General - Chad Harsha

A.G. Harsha announced former Attorney General Sara Hill has been appointed as a federal judge. The Oklahoma Senate Committee voted down the gaming compacts. He provided an update on several cases and then offered to answer any questions.
