LEGISLATIVE ACT 14-02

**AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #37-01 AUTHORIZING THE
COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002 – Mod. 5;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as “An Act Amending Legislative Act #37-01 Authorizing the Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2002 – Mod. 5”.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the “Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2002” or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by **\$970,981** for a total budget authority of **\$264,169,014**. The following items are identified as estimated funding sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

A. Motor Fuels Tax	\$1,247,535	(\$435,000 Appropriated)	Balance:	\$812,535
B. G/F special div.	\$250,000	(\$0 Appropriated)	Balance:	\$250,000
C. Gammon Trust	\$290,625	(\$290,625 Restricted)	Balance:	\$0
D. G/F settlement	\$253,685	(\$253,685 Restricted)	Balance:	\$0

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act 37-01 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This amendment changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of **\$970,981**, to wit:

- A. An increase in the **Motor Fuels Tax** budget authority of **\$116,442** for the Scattered Housing program.
- B. A net decrease in the **DOI-General** budget authority of **<\$1,153,983>** for the BIA funded Road Projects.
- C. A net increase in the **DOI-Self Governance Roads** budget authority of **\$308,862** for OSG funded Road Projects.
- D. A net increase in the **DHHS-General** budget authority of **\$1,206,352** for the Headstart and Early Headstart programs.
- E. A net increase in the **H.U.D.** budget authority of **\$493,308** for the 2000 and 2001 NAHASDA grants as well as an increase on the ROSS grant.


SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY


SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED
