A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DONATION OF ONE FLAT SCREEN MONITOR FOR COMPUTER, THREE HARD DRIVES, FIVE WIRELESS KEYBOARDS AND FIVE WIRELESS MICE TO THE CLAREMORE VETERANS CENTER IN CLAREMORE, OKLAHOMA

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government in behalf of the Cherokee people and;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America and;


WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation, has one (1) flat screen monitor for a computer, three (3) hard drives, five (5) wireless keyboards and five (5) wireless mice that are surplus to the needs of Cherokee Nation Information Systems and,

WHEREAS, the Claremore Veterans Center, in Claremore, Oklahoma, provides 24-hour medical and nursing care for veterans, many of whom are Cherokee citizens.






