1. Claremore Service Unit - George Valliere

No one was present to report.

2. Cherokee Nation Health Services - Connie Davis

Ms. Davis gave an overview of the number of patients seen by clinic. They have introduced a new scorecard for the primary care providers which measures quality, patient satisfaction, and productivity. On November 4th Principal Chief Baker signed a Proclamation naming November National Diabetes month. There will be several events and fundraisers at the clinics this month in recognition of the National Diabetes Month. The ground breaking for the Ochelata Clinic will be held on the 9th of December. Ms. Davis provided an update on the patient visits in the emergency

room, urgent care and other departments. An update was given on the ninety-day refill program. Councilor Lay requested clarification on the transportation program and if the CHR has been released for hire. Councilor FISHINGHAWK voiced concern for the need for an increase of doctors at the clinics especially with the opening of the new and expanded clinics. She requested a plan be brought forward next month on how to obtain more doctors. Councilor FULLBRIGHT inquired about extended hours at the clinics. Councilor Lay asked as to the number of appointments available during the extended hours at Nowata. Councilor BYRD inquired about the increase in appointment cancellations and how they compare to the private sector or Claremore.
