LEGISLATIVE ACT 17-12

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #20-11 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012 – Mod. 7; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as “An Act Amending Legislative Act #20-11 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2012 – Mod. 7”.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the “Comprehensive Operating Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2012” or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$12,551,722 for a total budget authority of \$506,886,242. The following items are identified as selective General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #20-11 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$12,660,026 to wit:

- A. A net increase in the **Tribal General Fund** budget authority of **\$467,144** related to the Deputy Chief, Secretary of Natural Resources and the Cash Reserve Fund.
- B. An increase in the **Motor Fuels Tax Fund** budget authority of **\$56,865** related to subsidy in the Cemetery Preservation program.
- C. An increase in the **Indirect Cost Pool** budget authority of **\$326,361** related to the Deputy Chief, Secretary of Natural Resources and the Health Executive Director budgets.
- D. An increase in the **DOI PL 102-477 Fund** budget authority of **\$4,550,470** related to the Child Care Program.
- E. An increase in the **IHS – Self Governance Fund** budget authority of **\$7,250,000** related to the new health clinic in Vinita.
- F. An increase in the **Private Fund** budget authority of **\$9,186** related to a Community Action Program.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS


To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.



Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

A. MARCH GRANTS RECEIVED (REPORTING ONLY):

B. MOD – 7 (13 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$12,496,296:

Tribal General Fund: (Net Increase - \$360,279)

(1): Deputy Chief: Requesting a budget specifically for the Office of Deputy Chief in the amount of \$117,535. This budget will provide for half of the Deputy Chief and three administrative staff, including a full-time receptionist and clerical position. This budget is splitting costs with the indirect cost funded budget in item #6 below.

(2): Secretary of Natural Resources: Requesting funding for a new cabinet level position provided for in Article VII Section 12 of the Constitution. This \$91,985 budget provides for the Secretary as well as an administrative assistant and is also splitting costs with the indirect cost funded budget in item #7 below.

(3): Unappropriated Revenues: This budget is making necessary adjustments to reflect net revenues available for appropriation (\$1,105,157). This budget is also providing for the Cash Reserve requirement outlined in the Attorney General's recent opinion 2012-CNAG-02 regarding the funding level required per statute (see item #4 below).

(4): Cash Reserve Fund: This budget reflects the reserve funding required fulfilling Legislative Act 05-02 (as amended). A reconciliation of the \$2,870,372 reserve amount is included with the attached budget.

(5): Cash Match for Grants: Requesting authority to transfer \$5,511 matching funds to item #13 below.

Indirect Cost Pool: (Increase - \$326,361)

(6): Deputy Chief – IDC: Requesting \$94,346 of indirect cost pool funding for the remaining split budget mentioned in item #1 above.

(7): Secretary of Natural Resources – IDC: Requesting \$83,295 of indirect cost pool funding for the remaining split budget mentioned in item #2 above.

(8): Health Executive Director IDC: Requesting an increase of \$148,720 of indirect cost pool funding for the administrative salaries of \$91,782 and related fringe benefits of \$56,938. This budget is increasing full-time equivalents from 15.7 positions to 16.4 positions.

DOI PL 102-477 Fund: (Increase - \$4,550,470)

(9): PL 102-477 Child Care: This budget is requesting an increase of carryover of \$4,538,581 to be utilized primarily on contracted services. It also includes a transfer out to the Capital Projects fund for the construction of the Stilwell Child Care Center reflected on Capital Budget Mod-3, to be considered by the committee on this date. *#5mm*

(10): ES Child Care: Requesting \$11,889 of spending authority on the carryover from interest income earned on the economic stimulus funding of prior years.

IHS Self-Governance Health Fund: (Increase - \$7,250,000)

(11): Vinita Clinic: Requesting additional spending authority of \$2,250,000 of Health carryover for start-up costs. The documentation indicates once IHS funds are received, a budget modification will be submitted to replace these carryover funds with IHS funds.

(12): Health M & I Projects: Requesting authority to transfer \$5,000,000 of carryover funds to the Capital Projects Fund. These project dollars are being requested for the furniture, fixtures and equipment purchases of the new Vinita Clinic. The capital transfer is also reflected on the Capital Budget Mod-3 under consideration this date.

Private Funding: (Increase - \$9,186)

(13): Community Action Project: Requesting additional spending authority of \$9,186 including additional matching dollars for a total current year budget of \$319,779. This adjustment is to the grant revenue as well as matching funds.

C. CEMETERIES, COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE & LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNDS:

The attached lists of projects have been approved, or are being requested to be approved in this Executive/Finance Committee. These projects have already been appropriated; therefore, there is no need to appropriate the funds again. This list is for informational purposes and is included within this mod package review for inclusion purposes.

Summary:

After reviewing the submission of Mod-7 by administration, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any concerns related to their respective carryover estimates. If I can provide any further information, please do not hesitate to contact me.
