Legislative Act 29-12

AN ACT TO REQUIRE CERTAIN TRIBAL POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY TO BE ENROLLED CITIZENS OF THE CHEROKEE NATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

Section 1. Title and Codification

This act shall be referred as the "Tribal Citizenship Requirement of Key Positions for the Cherokee Nation" and shall be codified as

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is for key position for the Cherokee Nation and job positions who work directly for the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation shall be held exclusively by enrolled citizens of the Cherokee Nation.

The positions subject to this legislation are as follows:

- a. Principal Chief's General Counsel
- b. Principal Chief's Chief of Staff
- c. Executive Director of Communications
- d. Executive Director of Government Relations
- e. Chief Executive Officer of Cherokee Nation Businesses

Section 3. Legislative History

a. "The Council shall have the power to establish laws which it shall deem necessary and proper for the good of the Nation, which shall not be contrary to the provisions of this Constitution."

Article V § 7. Cherokee Nation Constitution.

Section 4. Statutory Provisions

- a. The following positions shall be held only by enrolled citizens of the Cherokee Nation:
 - 1. Principal Chief's General Counsel
 - 2. Principal Chief's Chief of Staff
 - 3. Executive Director of Communications
 - 4. Executive Director of Government Relations
 - 5. Chief Executive Officer of Cherokee Nation Businesses

Section 5. Provisions as cumulative

The provisions of this act shall be cumulative to existing law.

Section 6. Severability

The provisions of this act are severable and if any part of provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this act.

Section 7. Emergency Declared

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and approval.

Dear Speaker Jordon and Council Members:

I am returning the enactments passed by the Tribal Council at the regular meeting held on August 13, 2012, as required by our Constitution. The Cherokee Constitution (Article VI, Section 10) requires that every enactment approved by the majority of the Council be presented to the Principal Chief before it becomes effective. I am returning the Resolutions signed, Legislative Act 29-12 unsigned, Legislative Act 30-12 and 31-12 signed.

- 1. Resolution No. 77-12, A Resolution Confirming the Nomination of Steve Wilson as a Commissioner of the Cherokee Nation Tax Commission.
- 2. Resolution No. 78-12, A Resolution Confirming the Nomination of Ruth Ann Weaver as a Commissioner of the Cherokee Nation Gaming Commission.

APPROVED LEGISLATIVE ACTS

1. Legislative Act 30-12, An Act Repealing and Superseding Cherokee Nation Law Regarding Labor and the Employment Rights Ordinance and Repealing Executive Order No. 12-10-CS, Contract Law and Employment Law, Declaring and Emergency.

2. Legislative Act 31-12, An Act Amending Legislative Act #20-11 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2012-Mod. 11; and Declaring an Emergency.
