**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHEROKEE  
NATION WAREHOUSE TO DONATE SURPLUS ITEMS  
TO MARYETTA PUBLIC SCHOOL**

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation, since time immemorial, has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Cherokee people.

**WHEREAS** the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government-to-government relationship with the United States of America.

**WHEREAS** the Cherokee Nation desires to donate these items in “as-is” condition




