WHEREAS, the Free and Independent Press for the Cherokee Nation, Editorial Board was created and authorized by Legislative Act 19-00;

WHEREAS, Maxie Thompson is nominated by the Council of the Cherokee Nation to fill a vacancy and serve a term as Editorial Board Member of the Cherokee Phoenix effective November 13, 2014 through April 1, 2019, as authorized by Legislative Act 16-09;

WHEREAS, Maxie Thompson is duly qualified to fill this vacancy pursuant to the laws of the Cherokee Nation.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CHEROKEE NATION that Maxie Thompson is hereby confirmed as a Board Member of the Editorial Board of the Cherokee Phoenix for a term effective November 13, 2014 through April 1, 2019 as authorized by Legislative Act 16-09, the Act of June 15, 2009.
