Cherokee Nation Businesses - Chuck Garrett

Ms. Molly Jarvis reported the strong headwinds continue into the 2026 financials. The uncertainty in federal contracting continues. The work force is currently at 67.5% Native American employment and 59.1% Cherokee employment. The 20th annual Cherokee Art Market is scheduled for October 11th and 12th. She offered to answer questions from the report.

Financial Report/Treasurer Report - Janees Taylor

Ms. Taylor announced they are a few days away from closing out fiscal year 2025. She stated it is a busy time for the procurement department. She stated they are watching the federal government in anticipation of a shutdown. She stated this isn't new territory and the preparations the Cherokee Nation has made. She offered to answer questions.

# **NEW BUSINESS**

1. 25-102 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHEROKEE NATION TO DONATE SURPLUS ITEM TO THE FAIRFIELD COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION INC.

Councilor Sam moved to approve. Councilor Easley seconded the motion. The motion carried.

2. TMP-425 DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION – TRIBAL COUNCIL BUDGET ITEMS:

Councilor Sam made a motion to enter discussion. Councilor Callison seconded the motion.

- 1. Community Meeting Funds currently at \$7,000 per Councilor. Request to increase to \$15,000 per Councilor.
- 2. Community Assistance Fund currently at \$50,000 per Councilor. Request to increase to \$75,000 per Councilor.
- 3. The need to hire a Public Relations person and a Communications person for the Tribal Council as Cherokee Nation employees. Total budget of \$150,000.
- 4. Codification to provide a better format of statute law and an online up to date presence.

A vote isn't necessary at this point, they will be presented in a Council budget modification and voted on at that point with the exception of the Community Meeting funds change.

Councilor Callison made a motion amend the Community Meeting Fund Policy to increase the community meeting funds to \$15,000 per Councilor. Councilor Deere seconded the motion. The motion carried.
