AN ACT RELATING TO AMENDMENT OF LA 16-96, THE CHEROKEE NATION GENERAL CORPORATION ACT, AS AMENDED BY LA 02-03, LA 04-04 AND LA 36-05 INCREASING DIVIDENDS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Councilor Bill John Baker announced this act would take an additional five-percent of the profits of the businesses and place it into contract health. He moved to approve and forward to Executive and Finance Committee. Councilor Hoskin Jr. seconded the motion.
