WHEREAS, a goal of the Cherokee Nation Human Services is to provide prevention, diversion and emergency shelter services to promote the health and well being of children, youth and families;

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation Human Services is applying for funding in the amount of \$83,333.00 to supplement the emergency shelter operations and supportive services of the John A. Ketcher Youth Services Center:

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION,** that the Council hereby authorizes an application for funding to the U.S. Family and Youth Services Bureau, Basic Center Runaway and Homeless Youth Program for Youth Shelter services, and that Principal Chief, Bill John Baker and/or his designee be authorized to sign documents necessary to submit said contract on behalf of the Cherokee Nation.
