Chief Hoskin announced he has signed an Executive Order giving preference in hiring to those who have been in the Career Readiness Program or have been a scholarship participant. The Veteran Administration will be expanding clinical services in a partnership with the Vinita Clinic. He provided an update on the Artist Recovery Act and the Cherokee Art Market. Tomorrow a celebration will be held at the Head Start Center. Inter-Tribal Council will meet this week at Hard Rock. At Large meeting will be held in California this weekend.
