CALL TO ORDER

Chair Anglen called the meeting to order at 1:15 p.m.

INVOCATION

Councilor Keener gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Jack D. Baker moved to approve the August 25th regular session minutes. Councilor Keener seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

Marshal Service - Sharon Wright

Mr. Pat Ragsdale reported Ms. Wright is out on medical and offered to answer questions from the report provided.

Councilor Garvin made a motion to amend the agenda to have discussion and possible action in regard to the voting places during this election. Councilor Cowan Watts seconded the motion. The motion failed with the following roll call vote:

Office of the Attorney General - Diane Hammons

Ms. Hammons announced in additional to the regular report a timeline of happenings within the Freedman case has also been provided. She offered to answer questions. Councilor Keener requested additional happenings since the timeline was provided be emailed to the Council and to the community groups. Councilor Coates requested an opinion on the replacement of spoiled absentee At Large ballots.

Codification - Todd Hembree

No one was present from the Election Commission; Mr. Hembree announced they did submit the Carter report. Councilor Cowan Watts voiced concern for the District 2 timeline not being approved by the Council. Mr. Hembree stated he would communicate this to the Election Commission. Councilors also raised question about additional voting precincts through the 8th of October. Mr. Hembree read a portion of Judge Kennedy's order.

Tax Commission - Sharon Swepston

Ms. Swepston offered to answer questions from the report provided.

Self-Governance - Vickie Hanvey

Ms. Hanvey reported a hearing was held on September 22nd in regard to Title IV amendments where the DOI testified they agreed with the language as written. She announced they are working on a supplemental contract disputes claim for Indian Health Service to include any third party revenue. They are also trying to file a CDA claim for contract support costs for 2005 as the statute of limitations runs out on the 30th of this month.

Gaming Commission - Jamie Hummingbird

Mr. Hummingbird provided his report and offered to answer questions.

Election Commission - Susan Plumb

Mr. Hembree announced there was no report to be given as everything is yet to settle down. He stated he would meet with Mr. Nason Morton as soon as practical and get the codification process rolling again. Councilor Cowan Watts announced it has been discovered that the impeachment act needs to be brought current with the constitution and will be presented as a special Rules meeting.

Registrar Citizenship Data Update - Todd Enlow

Mr. Enlow provided a handout of a map show the status update. They met with EODD last week, they have received the data from Sequoyah County, McIntosh County should be received next week and Adair County should be received within the

next thirty days. He reminded everyone that once the new fiscal year begins they will establish the contract to do Nowata County.

Mr. Ragsdale stated he would review the federal guidelines and provide feedback. Councilor Cowan Watts commented research would be provided prior to the meeting next month. She requested Councilor Thornton work with Mr. Hembree to develop draft language for submission.

Councilor Cowan Watts moved to table to next month. Councilor Garvin seconded the motion. The motion carried.
