APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Cowan Watts made a motion to approve the December 14, 2009 regular session minutes. Councilor Jack D. Baker seconded the motion. Motion carried.

REPORTS:

1. Talking Leaves Job Corp/Career Services/Voc. Ed - Diane Kelley

Ms. Debra Lack offered to answer any questions from the written report. Councilor Bill John Baker inquired about the Day Work Program being suspended. Ms. Lack stated it is due to lack of funds. Councilor Jack D. Baker stated he just received a budget request for the budget modification for tonight to go before Full Council to move \$750,000 contingency fund to the Day Work Program to carry through the rest of this year and then reimburse the contingency reserve from the carry over funds. He stated this isn't a motion. Ms. Lack introduced Kelly Forrest from Career Services.
