### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF SURPLUS EQUIPMENT TO FLINT RIDGE RURAL WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government in behalf of the Cherokee people;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation desires to assist in providing a source of clean drinking water to our communities:

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation has the following items currently located in Webbers Falls, OK, in its possession equipment that has been deemed surplus, namely:

- 1. (1)-US Filter Microfloc Trident Package Water Treatment Plant. 350gpm TR-210A
- 2. (2) Rotron Air Blowers Model DRS7X72
- 3. (2) 50HP High Service Horizontal Split Case Pumps (400 gpm)
- 4. (2) 50HP Variable Speed Drives
- 5. (3) 7-1/2 Variable Speed Drives
- 6. (1) Filter PLC and Panel
- 7. (1) SCADA PLC and Panel
- 8. (3) Rotork Acculators (for Various size valves)
- 9. (3) Rosemont Flow Meters (Various Sizes)
- 10. (1) Backwash Supply Pumps (1750 gpm)
