LEGISLATIVE ACT 17-25

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #34-24 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 - Mod. 9 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #34-24 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2025 – Mod. 9".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2025" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$\\$18,450,349\$ for a total budget authority of \$3,223,412,178. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Cumulative change in budget authority	\$ 18,450,349
Modification Request (see Section 4 below)	18,000,277
Grants Received & Authorized per LA 34-24 (detail attached)	\$ 450,072

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #34-24 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. <u>FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS</u>

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$\\$18,000,277\$ to wit:

- A. An increase in the **Tribally Funded** budget authority of \$ 0.
- B. An increase in the DOI PL 102-477 budget authority of \$ 17,953,277.
- C. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of \$ 47,000.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void, the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

B. MOD #9 Request - Increase in budget authority - \$ 18,000,277

 Unappropriated Reserve – 10102960 – Tribally Funded: Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$(542,828) to fund the increased Community Cultural Outreach budget in item 2. The new reserved by appropriation budget total is \$38,439,395.

- 2. <u>Community Cultural Outreach 10105770 Tribally Funded:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$542,828 for increased costs of At-Large events. See the "Significant Changes' section in budget narrative for details. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$1,391,393.
- 3. <u>Conservation Law Enforcement 32218300 DOI Self Governance:</u> New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$47,000. One time funding per authority to obligate (ATO) #8.
- 4. PL102 477 Human Services 32350000 Indirect Cost Pool: New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$17,953,2779. This will close out multiple individual grants funded by DHHS General and Department of Justice and consolidate into this PL 102 477 budget. PL102 477 consolidation allows for greater freedom on spending to Cherokee Nation's needs and simplifies budgeting/spending.
