1. Claremore Service Unit - George Valliere

Councilor Cowan Watts inquired about the CHS for the Cherokee Nation comparison no longer being a part of the report. She requested an update on the MRI and the approximate average daily capacity. She also inquired about the Marshal Service doing the drive by security checks. Councilor Thornton

inquired of the referrals in the last six months how many are Cherokee.

2. Cherokee Nation Health Services - Connie Davis

Ms. Davis gave an overview of the report provided. Councilor Glory Jordan requested a toe in toe out report for the emergency room and urgent care at Hastings for the next few months. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired about the behavioral health wait list at Claremore. She also asked for an update on the PACE program and the changes taking place with the board. She inquired which projects the joint venture could be used on if acquired. Councilor Lay requested an update on the electronic health records project and the dialysis center in Sallisaw. Councilor Thornton inquired about the staffing for the new hospital. He inquired about the changes to contract health when the new hospital and clinics all open. He requested a follow-up on the report from Camden. Councilor Buzzard inquired about a policy for home visits and patient transports. Councilor Taylor requested clarification on the immunizations listed in the report. Councilor Keener requested clarification on the referrals reported on page 20. He also inquired about the equipment for the new clinics. Councilor Keener inquired if we had purchased The Clinic in the Woods by Hastings.
