### **b.) Revenue and Taxation Division**

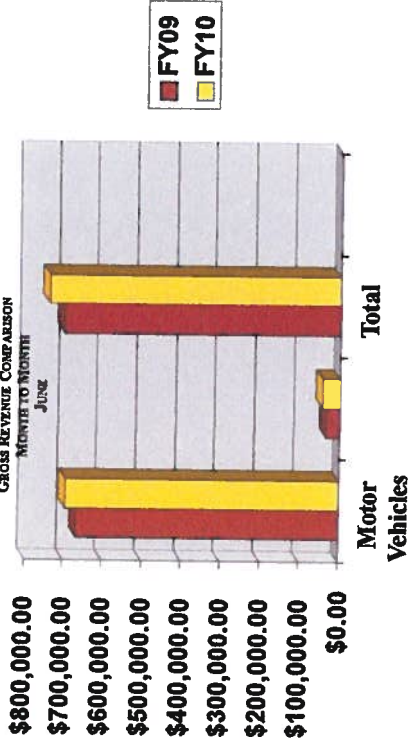
1. Year to Date Revenue and Taxation (Tobacco) for FY10 compared to FY09 as of June 30, had an overall decrease of 25.76%.

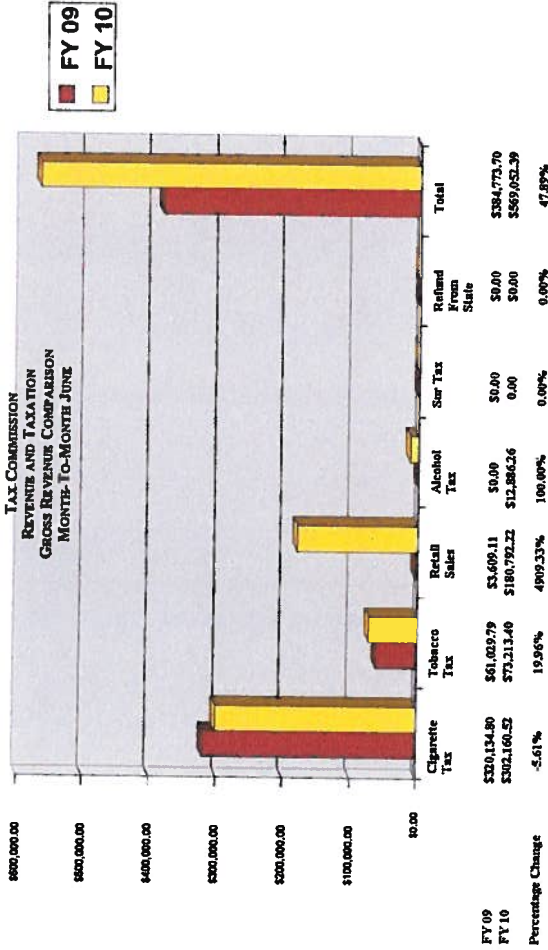

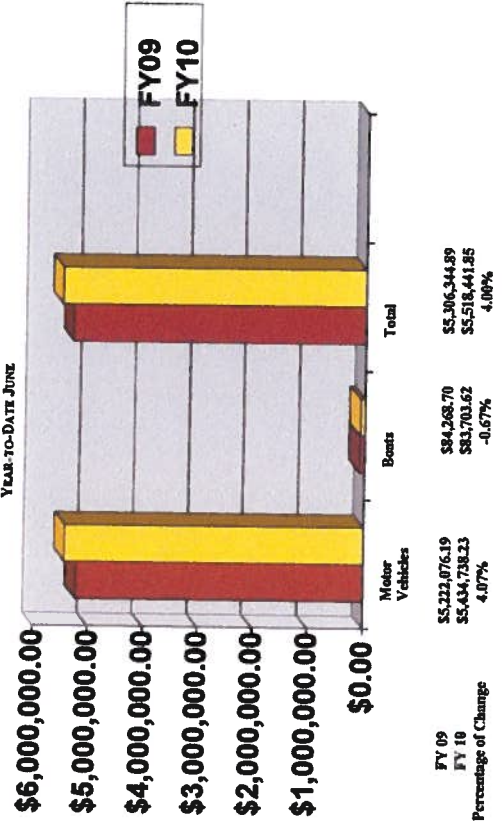

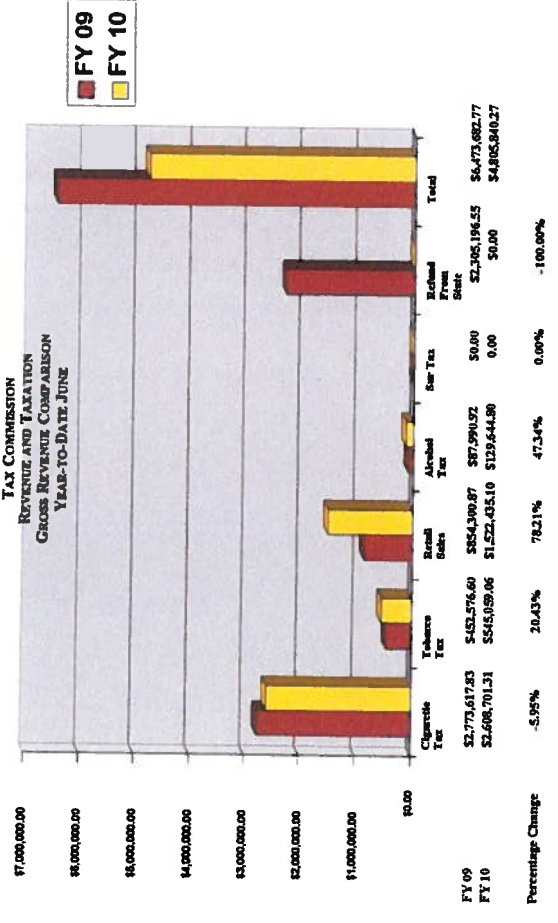
