#### CALL TO ORDER

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Councilor Deere moved to approve as submitted. Councilor Patzkowski seconded the motion. The motion carried.

#### STATE OF THE NATION

Chuck Hoskin, Jr., Principal Chief

Chief Hoskin commented current state of emergency due to the federal government shutdown. He announced the changes made to the SNAP benefits for Cherokee citizens during this emergency and gave appreciation to the Council for the laws in place that allow quick action in times of need. He stated we should be worried but to know that we are in a strong financial situation. The State of Oklahoma has \$3.69b in surplus and could put a portion of these funds in place to assist the women and children who are going to be cut off from the SNAP program. Chief Hoskin provided an update on the Claremore hospital with the changes to be made to the current building and the new facility. An Elder Summit was held at the Hard Rock yesterday for the northern area and tomorrow a summit will be held for the southern area at the Choeta Center. A celebration was held for the signing of the Heritage Center Act. An Act

prioritizing the care of Cherokee cemeteries has been signed. A Speakers Gathering and Language Summit has been scheduled. He announced a wage increase for employees who are fluent speakers. Chief Hoskin spoke of the opening of the ICW building here in Tahlequah. The opening of the Warner Community Building was held. The road in Bowlin Springs has been fixed. He attended the new housing in Ochelata. This year Flag Day was celebrated with the creator of the original Cherokee Nation flag, Stanley John. Chief Hoskin visited the native villages in Alaska who were affected by the recent storms and announced the Cherokee Nation is giving \$25,000 in recovery efforts. The Scared Summit is scheduled for November 4th and 5th at Hard Rock. A Veteran's Summit will be held on November 12th for the Southern Cherokees in Roland and on November 19th for the Northern Cherokees at the Craig County fairgrounds. Special guests were recognized as the 2025/2026 Cherokee Nation Royalty and Ambassadors.
