LEGISLATIVE ACT 25-24

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #22-23 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 – Mod. 9 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #22-23 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2024 – Mod. 9".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2024" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$16,008,779 for a total budget authority of \$3,128,843,626. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Grants Received & Authorized per LA 22-23 (detail attached) \$ 13,033,342

Modification Request (see Section 4 below) 2,975,437

Cumulative change in budget authority \$ 16,008,779

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #22-23 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. <u>FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS</u>

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by a decrease of § 2,975,437 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **Indirect Cost Pool** budget authority of § 1,775,000.
- B. An increase in the Enterprise budget authority of \$ 500,000.
- C. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of \$ 245,037.
- D. An increase in the USDA budget authority of \$ 455,400.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void, the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

B. MOD #9 Request - Increase in budget authority - \$ 2,975,437

Office Services Reimbursement – 20411600 – Indirect Cost Pool: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$1,775,000 for increased costs that include internet, telephone, cell phone, mailing cost, printing/copying and other office services. The increased costs are billed out the various department for a self-balancing budget. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$5,600,000.

- 2. <u>RBDG Loan Fund 41090550 Enterprise:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$500,000 for Rural Business Development Grant loans. The funding is provided by a transfer in of grant funding shown in budget 4. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$545,300.
- 3. <u>Tribal Climate Resilience 32214000 DOI Self Governance:</u> New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$245,037 for one-time special funding. See the budget narrative for the spending plan.
- 4. <u>USDA RBDG Revolving Loan Fund 34568000 USDA:</u> Modification requesting a \$500,000 transfer out to the Enterprise loan fund in budget 2 above and a reduction of expenditure total of \$44,600. Funding provided by grant revenue. The new budgeted expenditure/transfer total is \$670,188.
- 5. <u>Vinita Single Family Units 35660100 NAHASDA:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$(1,000,000) to reprogram the funds to the Housing Development budget in item 6. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$0.
- 6. <u>Housing Development 35660240 NAHASDA:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$1,000,000 to build Autumn Height Phase I. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$1,300,000.
