#### REPORTS:

Management Resources - Bruce Davis

Mr. Davis offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired if the Collinsville Food Distribution Center is still set for September of 2013. She requested notification of the grand opening. She requested a status update on the hay cutting. Councilor Byrd gave appreciation for the storm shelter process being expedited for the disabled elders.

# 1. TMP-274 DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: CHEROKEE NATION LANDFILL

Ms. Fan Robinson from the board at the Landfill reported they held a community meeting last Thursday with citizens of Candy Mink Springs, Killer Mountain, and Salem. The meeting was well attended with a focus group being held at the end of the meeting the majority of those in attendance requested the landfill remain open. Councilor Keener inquired about some of the other discussion items at the community meeting. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired about a budget for keeping the landfill open and if recycling efforts have been considered. Councilor Byrd inquired about a closure cost for this fiscal year. Ms. Robinson announced they would be having annual community meetings. Councilor Glory-Jordan inquired if the budget is for local trash only. She inquired if a budget has been submitted for review.

Councilor Glory-Jordan moved to table for one month to allow discussion during the FY2014 budget hearings. Councilor Hoskin Jr. seconded the motion.

Discussion was held on the specifics of the budget requested. Ms. Robinson stated they need a decision from the Council as to keep the landfill open or to close. Discussion was held as to who is to make that determination. Councilor Cowan Watts requested the Chair and Co-Chair of Executive & Finance Committee work with CNB to determine if this is something that can be funded for the next fiscal year.

The motion to table for one month carried with no opposition.
