#### LEGISLATIVE ACT 43-07

# AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #37-07 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008 – Mod. 2; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

#### SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #37-07 Authorizing the Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2008 – Mod. 2".

#### SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2008" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$10,180,259 for a total budget authority of \$429,115,679. The following items are identified as estimated General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

#### **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #37-07 are applicable to this amendment.

#### SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This amendment changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$10,180,259 to wit:

A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of \$2,278,933 related to several programs prior year unexpended funds, an inter-program contract with CNE, and additional Constitutional Defense funding.

- B. A net increase in the **Motor Fuels Tax Fund** budget authority of <u>\$715,545</u> primarily related to the prior year carryover of the Higher Education Scholarship programs.
- C. An increase in the **Indirect Cost Pool** spending authority of \$826,009, offset by a reduction in the IDC Recovery, resulting in <u>\$0</u> net increase. This increase is to fund the Financial, Management and Human Resources departments increased capacity to support the increased Housing Group activities.
- D. An increase in the Enterprise Fund budget authority of \$1,056,205 to authorize the Intermediary Relending loan program.
- E. An increase in the **Internal Lease Pool** budget authority of \$1,000,000 to authorize the utilization of remaining proceeds from long-term debt. This is a capital expenditure funding for the renovation and improvements of the Markoma Property.
- F. A decrease in the **DOI-Self Governance Fund** budget authority of <\$1,036,043> partially related to the Marshals inter-company contract with CNE as well as a decrease in the H.I.P. program prior year carryover.
- G. An increase in the **HUD Fund** budget authority of \$1,000,000 to accommodate the Nation assuming the Mutual Help housing operations from the Housing Authority.
- H. A net increase in the **NAHASDA Fund** budget authority of \$4,691,138 also related to the Nation assuming the administration of the housing operations from the Housing Authority.
- I. An increase in **Private Funding** budget authority of <u>\$461,937</u> related to a pilot Early Childhood Program between the Nation and Community Action Project (CAP) in Tulsa.
- J. A net increase in the **Special Revenue-Other Fund** budget authority of \$12,544 related to the Tribal Youth Council and the JOM Conference Special Registrant.

#### SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

#### SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

#### SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

#### SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Budget Mod. #2 Review

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

#### A. NOVEMBER - GRANTS RECEIVED (REPORTING ONLY):

#### B. MOD - 2 (31 budgets) Net Increase in budget authority - \$10,729,884:

#### GENERAL FUND: (Net Increase - \$3,366,031)

- (1): <u>Health Services Deputy Group Leader:</u> Requesting to transfer **\$137,812** from the "Succession Planning" budget (see item #9) into this new accounting unit.
- (2): <u>Constitutional Defense Fund:</u> Requesting authority to bring forward the unspent **\$217,571** of the FY07 \$1,220,000 budget, to bring the total FY08 current year budget authority to \$1,717,571.
- (3): <u>Marshal Service CNE Contract</u>: Requesting spending authority for **\$760,155** funded by an intercompany contract with CNE utilizing 8 officers. The budget is planning on utilizing existing marshal service personnel and is offset by budget reductions in the programs Motor Fuels Tax budget (item #15) as well as their DOI S/G budget (item #18).

- (4): <u>Higher Education Pell Scholarships:</u> Requesting spending authority of an additional \$850,000 of unexpended funds from FY07 for a total budget in FY08 of \$1,675,000 for scholarship increases for the Pell students.
- (5): <u>Cherokee Immersion Projects</u>: Requesting spending authority of an additional **\$250,000** of unexpended funds from FY07 for a total budget authority in FY08 of \$2,574,135. This carryover request is to complete the previously authorized projects, including building renovations, playground equipment, fencing, toys, etc.
- (6): <u>Connors Nursing Cohort:</u> Requesting spending authority of an additional \$65,000 of unexpended funds from FY07 for a total budget authority in FY08 of \$120,000.
- (7): <u>Tribal Youth Council:</u> Requesting spending authority of an additional **\$6,057** of funds, with \$5,000 coming from closing out the expendable trust accounting unit (item #30) as well as \$1,057 of carryover from FY07.
- (8): <u>History Course Project:</u> Requesting a carryover adjustment of the prior year unexpended funds of <\$11,800>.
- (9): <u>Succession Planning</u>: Requesting the offsetting decrease of **<\$137,812>** to accommodate the Health Services Deputy Group Leader to be moved to item #1 above.
- (10): Cash Match For Grants: Requesting another \$87,098 for a cash match for item #29 below. I would recommend this item be funded by the already appropriated \$500,000 specifically for these types of grant matching requirements, instead of earmarking additional discretionary funds for a purpose already funded.
- (11): Markoma Property: Requesting \$1,000,000 for capital expenditures at the Markoma Property. These expenditures are for renovations and infrastructure repairs. I recommend this request be included in the capital expansion plan along with the other long term capital-type expenditures and not funded by discretionary General Fund dollars as requested. I believe long-term capital expenditures should be funded by long-term revenue streams and not current year dollars that otherwise would be available for direct services and programs.
  - (12): <u>SHS Multipurpose Center Sound/Lights:</u> Requesting authority to spend **\$141,950** of carryover funds originally appropriated in FY07 but remain unobligated.

#### MOTOR FUELS TAX FUND: (Increase - \$715,545)

- (13): <u>Higher Ed. Scholarships:</u> Requesting the authorization to utilize \$777,105 of the previous year's carryover to fund non-pell eligible scholarship applicants. This will bring the total current year spending authority to \$3,221,105.
- (14): <u>Graduate Scholarships:</u> Requesting the authorization to utilize **\$45,000** of the previous year's carryover to fund graduate scholarship applicants. This will bring the total current year spending authority to \$331,000.
- (15): MFT-Law Enforcement: Reducing current year budget by <\$106,560> related to the CNE intercompany contract identified in item #3 above.

#### INDIRECT COST POOL: (Increase - \$826,009) \* Added IDC Recovery 2010000 (870,009)

Housing Administration: A new request of \$826,009 in Indirect Cost Pool funds. The documentation states the purpose of this request is to fund increased capacity for Financial, Management & Human Resources to support housing group activities. No payroll worksheet was submitted with this budget, nor any further justification or documentation. No accounting unit code is tied to this request either (ie: 204xxx). This budget indicates it will fund 24 additional overhead staff; yet does not identify the position titles, departments or salary levels. Additionally, the Indirect Cost Pool Recovery is not being increased accordingly to keep the pool in balance, which has been the long-standing budgetary practice of the Indirect Cost Pool. Failing to do so will yield the comprehensive budget with this modification package out-of-balance. If the Council decides to fund this request, I recommend at a minimum, an increased IDC recovery (au-2040000) be added to this mod package in the same amount of funding to this budget.

(17): Intermediary Relending Program: Requesting an increase in source of funds by \$1,017,700 yet is only requesting an increase in spending authority of \$690,267 of it. This increase in funds is partially due to an increase in FY07 carryover of \$517,700 as well as a \$500,000 loan from USDA. This program is budgeting not to obligate \$366,000 of its current year available funds.

#### DOI-SELF GOVERNANCE FUND: (Decrease - <\$1,036,043>)

(18): Marshal Service: Reducing this budget by <\$567,133> as a result of the CNE contract being budgeted on the General Fund (see item #3).

(19): HIP - HACM: Requesting a carryover reduction of <\$468,910> primarily in the supplies and contract service line items. I would recommend clarification from the Treasurer which department will be administering these funds due to the fact documentation submitted identifies this budget as a HACN budget; however, other documents make no mention of the Housing Authority. I would anticipate due to recent public communications, this will be administered by the Nation, and merely the name in the financial system needs changed.

#### HUD: (Increase - \$1,000,000)

(20): MH Operations: Requesting \$1,000,000 in spending authority for the Nation to assume the Mutual Help Housing operations. These funds are derived from receipts of house payments. Again, this budget request is not identifying any financial system accounting unit to tie the appropriation to (ie-355xxxx). Although it identifies 9 employees at a total salary amount of \$245,000; no payroll worksheet was submitted with this budget, nor any further justification or documentation. Accordingly it does not identify the position titles, grades or salary levels.

#### NAHASDA: (Increase - \$4,691,138)

The following items are due to the Nation assuming the administration of each respective program:

Note: The FY07 Comprehensive Budget contained \$27,002,418 of funding, including all program income. This increase above brings the total to \$31,693,556; however, the FY07 Amended Indian Housing Plan approved in Resolution 46-07 identifies only \$30,850,102 of total funding, including all program income. This results in an approved budget of \$843,454 more than the Indian Housing Plan identifies as available funds, including program income. If this is due to program payments made by clients, we need to all understand the IHP does not reflect every type of income sourcing these blocks of budgets.

#### PRIVATE FUNDING: (Increase - \$461,937)

(29): <u>CAP (Community Action Project) Program:</u> Requesting spending authority of **\$461,937** related to a new Pilot Early Childhood Program between the Cherokee Nation and the Tulsa Community Action Project. This budget is utilizing an \$87,098 cash match (see item #10 above) and obtaining an \$87,098 private donation in the same amount. The "Provider Agreement" identifies matching these sources (\$174,197); however, no documentation was submitted verifying the private donations were obtained therefore obligating the CAP to match the private donation.

#### SPECIAL REVENUE - OTHER: (Net Increase - \$15,000)

(30): Tribal Youth Council - Expendable Trust: Requesting to transfer this <\$5,000> budget to item #7 above.

(31): <u>JOM Conference – Special Registration</u>: Requesting an increase of \$20,000 to the current year's budget based upon carryover from the prior year. This program does not have \$20,000 of carryover, but instead \$17,544. The program experienced a revenue shortfall in FY07 of over \$3,200. I recommend this budget be reduced by <\$2,456>, or we will need to fund this difference with current year monies available.

#### C. COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE & LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNDS:

The attached lists of projects have been approved, or are being requested to be approved in this Executive/Finance Committee. These projects have already been appropriated; therefore, there is no need to appropriate the funds again. This list is for informational purposes and is included within this mod package review for inclusion purposes.

#### Summary:

After reviewing the submission of Mod-2, I would point out the following budget items and related comments: Items 10, 11, 16, 29, 31 and the NAHASDA total funding clarification.
