**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHEROKEE
NATION WAREHOUSE TO DONATE SURPLUS ITEMS
TO PEAVINE PUBLIC SCHOOL**

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation, since time immemorial, has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Cherokee people.

WHEREAS the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government-to-government relationship with the United States of America.

WHEREAS the Cherokee Nation desires to donate these items in “as-is” condition


1 – Shredder

WHEREAS the Peavine Public School, located within the Cherokee Nation's jurisdictional boundaries, operates on limited funds, and donating said item would benefit them greatly.




