AN ACT RELATING TO CHEROKEE NATION OF OKLAHOMA  
LAW REGARDING RUNOFFS; AMENDING CNCA SECTION  
10-5-72; ADDING NEW ITEMS AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:


## SECTION 10-5-72. Runoffs

There shall be a run off for the Offices of Principal Chief and Deputy Principal Chief for the ~~two-top-men~~ two top candidates in each of the respective offices with the exception, if ~~one-man~~ one candidate for each of the respective positions should obtain a simple majority of the votes cast for the respective office. A simple majority meaning over 50 percent or any fraction thereof. In the event of a tie for the last place or places in the Council election, a subsequent election shall be held pursuant to rules developed by the Tribal Election Committee.
