A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL TO THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A CHEROKEE **RADON PILOT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised sovereign rights of selfgovernment in behalf of the Cherokee people;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation operates the Office of Environmental Programs;

WHEREAS, Cherokee Nation desires to develop a Cherokee Radon Pilot Project to establish a radon workshop for homeowners and test high-risk areas for radon gas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION, that the Cherokee Nation Council authorizes Environmental Programs to submit a proposal to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6/Air Toxics Division: Cherokee Radon Pilot Program and that Chad Smith, Principal Chief (or his designee) shall be authorized to execute all official matters in this regard.
