LEGISLATIVE ACT 26-09

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #21-09 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010 – Mod. 2; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #21-09 Authorizing the Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2010 – Mod. 2".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2010" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$6,669,849 for a total budget authority of \$543,671,975. The following items are identified as estimated General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #21-09 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. <u>FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS</u>

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This amendment changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$6,669,849 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of <u>\$898,221</u> primarily related to capital project funding for the Vinita Health Clinic and Male Seminary Administrative parking lot.
- B. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance Fund** budget authority of <u>\$74,931</u> related to a Marshal Service reimbursement for prior period expenditures.

- C. An increase in the **DOI PL 102-477 Fund** budget authority of \$4,113,392 related to prior period economic stimulus funding for the Child Care Program.
- D. An increase in the **IHS Self Governance Health Fund** budget authority of \$1,571,290 of economic stimulus funding for a roof replacement at Hastings Hospital and Direct Digital Controls upgrades.
- E. An increase in the **Special Revenue Other Fund** budget authority of \$12,015 related to a subsidy for the Angels of the Cherokee program.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Review of Budget Modification - 2

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

NOVEMBER - GRANTS RECEIVED (REPORTING ONLY):

B. MOD - 2 (7 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$6,632,162: + \$12,015 TFR OUT

General Fund: (Increase - \$872,549)

- (1): Marshal Service CNE Contract: Requesting authority to expend an additional \$41,972 pursuant to the CNE contract for a total budget for FY2010 of \$858,256.
- (2): Roads Construction: Requesting authority to expend carryover capital project funds in the amount of \$246,202 related to the Male Seminary Administrative parking lot originally funded for \$250,000 in the prior year and wasn't completed.
- (3): Vinita Clinic Utilities: Requesting authority to expend carryover capital project funds in the amount of \$584,375 related to the joint venture project originally funded for \$639,000 in the prior year and wasn't completed. +13,657 = #598,032 (see Affected

DOI Self Governance: (Increase - \$74,931)

(4): Marshal Service: Requesting an increase in spending authority of \$74,931 related to a reimbursement of expenses related to the "Peacekeeper Mission" from FY2008. The funding award is dated October 28th 2008.

This reimbursement of federal funds, after the fact, creates a form of revenue windfall that has been requested to be expended by the proper department. This department; however, receives subsidized funding from tribal sources for equipment and supplies, i.e. General Fund and the Motor Fuels Tax Fund. I recommend proper justification be requested as to why the tribal funds are not being reduced to "free-up" those discretionary funds by this same amount, due to these new unbudgeted federal funds.

DOI - PL 102-477: (Increase - \$4,113,392)

(5): <u>ES Child Care Program:</u> Requesting spending authority of \$4,113,392 of FY09 Economic Stimulus funding for the Child Care Program.

IHS Self Governance - Health: (Increase - \$1,571,290)

- (6): <u>ES Maintenance and Improvement:</u> Requesting spending authority of \$1,512,300 for a roof replacement at the Hastings Hospital in the amount of \$522,500 and a Direct Digital Controls upgrade in the amount of \$989,800.
- (7): <u>ES Equipment:</u> Requesting spending authority in the amount of \$58,990 of prior year economic stimulus funding for the purchase of two (2) Funduscopic Cameras.

C. LAW ENFORCEMENT & CEMETERIES FUNDS:

The attached lists of projects have been approved, or are being requested to be approved in this Executive/Finance Committee. These projects have already been appropriated; therefore, there is no need to appropriate the funds again. This list is for informational purposes and is included within this mod package review for inclusion purposes.

Summary:

After reviewing the submission of Mod-2 by administration, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any concerns related to their respective carryover estimates. As noted on item (4); however, I would recommend adequate justification from the Marshal Service for not reducing the tribal funding budgets in response to acquiring the additional federal funds which reimbursed for 2008 expenditures.
