APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Baker moved to approve the July 14th regular session minutes. Councilor Hargis seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

1. Human Services Department - Marsha Lamb

Ms. Lamb provided an update on the clothing voucher program and the number of applications given to date. They are still in planning on the Veteran's trip to Washington D. C. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired about the Tulsa and Rogers County advocate.

2. Community Services - Ron Qualls

Mr. Qualls gave an update on the Community Cultural Outreach program. Councilor Coates requested clarification on the number of At Large groups. She also inquired how the picnic dates are chosen. Councilor Coates inquired if there are social media policies for the staff of the CCO program. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired about a

waterline agreement compacts with the Delaware and possibly the UKB. Mr. Billy Hix gave an overview of the agreement with the Delaware tribe.

3. Housing Services - Gary Cooper

Mr. Cooper gave an update on the Negotiated Rule Making sessions. Just prior to Congress going into recess the NAHASDA reauthorization passed out of the House Financial Service Committee. They will be accepting college housing applications through the 15th of this month. Councilor Cowan Watts requested clarification on the number of homes built to date. She also requested a tour of the homes being built in her area. Councilor Coates inquired about rental assistance process for the elderly and handicapped. Councilor Buzzard inquired if the Negotiated Rule Making still uses Census data. Mr. Cooper gave a list of houses by county.

4. Roads & Transportation - Michael Lynn

Mr. Lynn gave an update on the Cherokee Nation Industrial Park in Stilwell, the SHS intersection, the Tenkiller School road and the NE Ft. Gibson road. Councilor Glory Jordan inquired about the beetle issue on the NE Ft. Gibson road. She also requested clarification on the Hulbert/Lost City road project. She inquired about Cedar Hollow 1 and 2 being terminated. Councilor Walkingstick inquired about the burden of the intersection construction at SHS during the Cherokee National Holiday. Councilor Snell inquired about the right of way responsibility of a road project once a road is complete. Councilor Buzzard inquired about the Jay clinic road. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired about any funding with the UKB in regard to roads or transit. Councilor Byrd inquired about Coffey Hollow Road. Chair Lay inquired about the turn off to the Ochelata Clinic.
