
BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

10-5-41. Requests for absentee ballots generally


A registered voter of the Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma who swears or affirms that he or she will be unable to vote in person may make a written request to the Chairman of the Tribal Election Committee for an absentee ballot. The request must contain the following information:

- (1) Name.
- (2) Date of Birth.
- (3) Address
- (4) Voter Registration Number
- ~~(5) Dawes Commission roll number~~
- (5) Signature of person making request
- ~~(6) Signature of witness~~
- (6) Notarization of signature of person making request; Notary should print or type their name; county where notary resides.
- ~~(7) Address of witness.~~
