A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF MARTY D. MATLOCK AS A COMMISSIONER OF CHEROKEE NATION ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government in behalf of the Cherokee people;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Commission was created and authorized by Title 63 Section 101 of the Cherokee Nation Code Annotated (CNCA);


WHEREAS, the Principal Chief is authorized to appoint the members of the Commission subject to majority vote of the Council of the Cherokee Nation; and

WHEREAS, Marty D. Matlock is duly qualified to be a Commisisoner, pursuant to the laws of the Cherokee Nation;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION, that Marty D. Matlock is hereby confirmed as being reappointed as a Commissioner of Cherokee Nation Environmental Protection Commission, for the term October 1, 2013 expiring September 30, 2014, in order to allow the Commission to have staggered terms, as authorized by Title 63 Section 101 (A) of the Cherokee Nation Code Annotated (CNCA).


CERTIFICATION





TITLE: A RESOLUTION Confirming the Reappointment of MARTY D. MATLOCK as a Commissioner of the Cherokee Nation Environmental Protection Commission

NARRATIVE:

The Environmental Protection Commission was created and authorized by Title 63 Section 101 of the Cherokee Nation Code Annotated (CNCA);

The Principal Chief is authorized to appoint the members of the Commission subject to majority vote of the Council of the Cherokee Nation;

The term of Commissioner of the Cherokee Nation Environmental Protection Commission is Four (4) years; Commissioner Marty D. Matlock's term expired January of 2012 and is currently held by Marty D. Matlock; and

Marty D. Matlock is duly qualified to be reappointed to fill this seat; and in order to get the Commission appointees back on staggered terms, his term will begin October 1, 2013 and expire September 30, 2014.
