APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Jack D. Baker moved to approve the September 13th regular session minutes. Councilor Thornton seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Councilor Buzzard moved to amend the agenda to include a resolution pertaining to Question 10 of the 25 CFR Part 170 Regulations and the IRR Road system. Councilor Thornton seconded the motion. Motion carried.

REPORTS:

1. Management Resources - Angela Drewes

Ms. Drewes offered to answer questions from the written report provided. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired if a consultation had been done with the National Parks Service regarding gathering rights as it is an issue with the Eastern Band of Cherokees. Ms. Drewes stated she would research and provide feedback. Councilor Cowan Watts requested a formal update that the next meeting. Councilor Glory-Jordan inquired as to the plans for the used car lot property purchased next to the Cort Mall. Ms. Drewes commented is part of the Cultural Tourism/Art District and that location is being considered for the pickup/drop off of the tour buses. Councilor Glory-Jordan requested notification once contracts are signed. Ms. Drewes announced she provided by email to the Council staff for distribution regarding the Arkansas Riverbed Settlement account depicting all of the sales and all of the settlement installments received. Councilor Buzzard inquired about having a day-worker stay at the Bull Hollow Office and the Dahlonegah Shop at night as a security measure to keep them from being broken into. Councilor Thornton announced he has received good comments pertaining to the Sallisaw Creek Park. People are enjoying staying there now that security is in place. He commented about bringing forward a resolution naming the park and designating it as a Cherokee National Park.

2. Real Estate Services - Linda Donelson

Ms. Donelson offered to answer questions from her report. Councilor Cowan Watts gave clarification of the intent of legislation that has been tabled several months on the Full Council agenda. The intent is when we have a property donation proposed to us that the Council would be informed prior to any decision being made. Ms. Paula Ragsdale commented there is a provision where the Treasurer would provide a report.

Mr. Elkins handed out his written report and gave a brief overview. He commented they currently have two Environmental Protection Commissioners. He announced they got approval on the D.O.E. money this last month.
