**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHEROKEE NATION TO OBTAIN BUFFALO MEAT THROUGH THE INTERTRIBAL BUFFALO COUNCIL FROM THE BADLANDS IN SOUTH DAKOTA**

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government in behalf of the Cherokee people; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation engages in numerous agricultural endeavors and is desirous of expanding activities within this field for the betterment of the Cherokee Nation and its Citizens; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation is a working member in the InterTribal Buffalo Council (ITBC) is taking necessary steps for the development and required expertise needed for successful American Bison husbandry; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation can obtain buffalo meat through the InterTribal Buffalo Council from the Bad Lands in South Dakota; and, therefore,


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION**, that the Cherokee Nation is hereby authorized to obtain buffalo meat through the InterTribal Buffalo Council from the Bad Lands in South Dakota.




