LEGISLATIVE ACT <u>07-08</u>

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #37-07 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008 – Mod. 6; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #37-07 Authorizing the Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2008 – Mod. 6".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2008" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$6,579,015 for a total budget authority of \$444,627,314. The following items are identified as estimated General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #37-07 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This amendment changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by a net increase of \$6,579,015 to wit:

A. A net increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of \$6,245,930 primarily related to the Contract Health Program, Constitutional Defense Fund, Self Help Community Assistance as well as consolidating the Natural Resource Force Account budget with the Land Development budget.

- B. A net increase in the **Indirect Cost Pool** budget authority of <u>\$45,099</u> related to the transfer of staff from the Housing Authority and an adjustment of the IDC Recovery.
- C. A net decrease in the **Tribal Force Account Fund** budget authority of \square-strength related to the Natural Resource Force Account budget moving into the Land Development budget; partially offset by an inter-program agreement between the EPC and Realty Departments.
- D. An increase in the **USDA Fund** budget authority of \$300,000 related to a new Community Planning Grant.
- E. A net increase in the NAHASDA Fund budget authority of \$138,304 primarily related to unbudgeted balances in the 2007 Indian Housing Plan on the Career Service Group's Resident Services Program.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Budget Mod. #6 Review

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

A. MARCH - GRANTS RECEIVED (REPORTING ONLY):

Funding SourceProgram\$AmountD.H.H.S. - GeneralSTD Support Services Program (In-kind adj.)\$15,572Federal OtherJuvenile Healing to Wellness Court (In-kind adj.)\$331,603TOTAL NET GRANTS RECEIVED\$347.175

B. MOD - 6 (13 budgets) Net Increase in budget authority - \$886,673. (see adj's in

GENERAL FUND: (Net Increase - \$545,930)

- (1): <u>Charitable Contributions:</u> Requesting to designate \$5,000 of the undesignated balance for "Safe Kids". The budget reflects the original \$20,000 undesignated amount adjusted for <\$10,000>-Murrell Home, <\$4,000>-Oaks Generator, <\$5,000>-Safe Kids; leaving a balance of \$1,000).
- (2): <u>Gen Fund Operations:</u> Requesting to reduce the transfer associated with the Natural Resources Force Accounts prior year's deficit (see item 7 below) by **<\$67,859>**.
- (3): <u>Self Help Emergency Assistance</u>: Requesting a funding increase of **\$200,070** related to the weatherization program administered by Community Services group.
- (4): Rural Fire Stations: Requesting \$2,609 in spending authority to include Inola Volunteer Fire Department.
- (5): <u>Land Development:</u> Requesting an increase of **\$411,110** to combine the Natural Resources Force Account budget with this budget as well as recognize the debt service payments related to long-term debt.

INDIRECT COST POOL: (Increase - \$52,757)

(6): <u>Evaluation & Compliance:</u> Requesting an increase of \$52,757 to absorb 1 additional FTE associated with the transfer of the Housing Authority employees.

Note: The previous mod package reflected a net decrease of <\$45,099> in the Indirect Cost Pool. This pool is designed to budget a break even through the IDC Recovery budget. The net increase of this request of \$52,757 <less> last months decrease of <\$45,099> results in a net increase of \$7,658. This budget needs an increase in the IDC Recovery budget (2040000) of the <\$7,658> to ensure the pool stays in budgeted balance.

<u>Tribal Force Account Fund: (Net Decrease - <\$150,318>)</u>

- (7): Natural Resources Force Account: Requesting a reduction of <\$170,318> to remove this budget and transfer it to the Land Development Account (see item #5 above); as well as provide for the prior year's deficit of \$198,619.
- (8): <u>EPC Projects:</u> Requesting an increase of **\$20,000** provided by Inter-program services to the Realty Department.

U.S.D.A. Fund: (Increase \$300,000)

(9): <u>USDA Community Planning:</u> Requesting an increase of **\$300,000** for a new planning grant. The grant amount is \$150,000; with the remaining \$150,000 being matched by a transfer from the NAHASDA fund (see item #10 below).

NAHASDA Fund: (Net Increase - \$138,304)

- (10): <u>2006 IHP Community Planning:</u> Requesting to transfer the previously approved budget to the USDA Community Planning budget mentioned above. These funds are being matched by the USDA.
- (11): Resident Services Career Services: Requesting an increase of \$144,916 related to the unexpended balance from the prior year allocated from the '07 IHP.
- (12): <u>Elderly Housing/Protective Services 2007 IHP:</u> Requesting a decrease of **<\$2,045>** to adjust the unexpended balance from the prior year's '07 IHP allocation.
- (13): Resident Services Human Services: Requesting a decrease of <\$4,567> to adjust the unexpended balance from the prior year's '07 IHP allocation.

C. COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE & LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNDS:

The attached lists of projects have been approved, or are being requested to be approved in this Executive/Finance Committee. These projects have already been appropriated; therefore, there is no need to appropriate the funds again. This list is for informational purposes and is included within this mod package review for inclusion purposes.

Summary:

After reviewing the submission of Mod-6; with the exception the Indirect Cost Pool's notation and recommended action, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests and nor do I have any concerns related to their respective carryover estimates.
