LEGISLATIVE ACT 03-14

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #21-13 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 – Mod. 5; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #21-13 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2014 – Mod. 5".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2014" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$1,702,224 for a total budget authority of \$586,635,715. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Grants Received & Authorized per LA-21-13 (detail attached)	\$ (49,485)
Modification Request (see Section 4 below)	1,751,709
Cumulative change in budget authority	\$ 1,702,224

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #21-13 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. <u>FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS</u>

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of § 1,751,709 to wit:

- A. An increase in the General Fund budget authority of \$ 973,197.
- B. An increase in the Motor Vehicle Tax budget authority of § 707,954.
- C. An increase in the **IHS Self Goverance Health** budget authority of § 70,558.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

B. MOD #5 Request - (9 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$1,751,709

- 1. <u>Economic Development 1010563 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$973,197. There is a small reduction related to carryover reconciliation; however, \$1,110,073 is additional revenue from an amendment to the MOU with CNB.
- 2. MVT Public Schools 1051000 General Fund-Vehicle Tax: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$237,963 related to the 2013 allocation of Motor Vehicle Tax Revenue, final carryover, and balancing of previous estimates. The total 38% allocation to schools is \$3,600,736 and the new total for this budget is now \$3,212,451. See budgets in items 3, 4, 5, and 6 below for other school allocations.

- 3. MVT Sequoyah High School 1051010 General Fund-Vehicle Tax: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$17,044 related to the 2013 allocation of Motor Vehicle Tax Revenue, final carryover, and balancing of previous estimates. The new total for this budget is now \$107,044.
- 4. MVT Head Start 1051011 General Fund-Vehicle Tax: Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$31,114 related to the 2013 allocation of Motor Vehicle Tax Revenue, final carryover, and balancing of previous estimates. The new total for this budget is now \$82,381.
- 5. <u>MVT Immersion 1051012 General Fund-Vehicle Tax:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$18,364 related to the 2013 allocation of Motor Vehicle Tax Revenue, final carryover, and balancing of previous estimates. The new total for this budget is now \$28,364.
- 6. MVT Public School Coop 1051020 General Fund-Vehicle Tax: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$235,415 related to the 2013 allocation of Motor Vehicle Tax Revenue, final carryover, and balancing of previous estimates. The new total for this budget is now \$570,159. This budget is for the A-F scorecard assistance to public schools and is the 5% of 38% School allocation and the matching 5% from General Fund. The matching amount from General Fund is reserved out of the residual of the Motor Vehicle Tax that goes to General Fund.
- 7. MVT Highways Administration 1051020 General Fund-Vehicle Tax: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$235,415 related to the 2013 allocation of Motor Vehicle Tax Revenue and balancing of previously estimated final carryover. The new total for this budget is now \$414,434 consisting of \$224,922 carryover and \$189,512 current allocation from 2013 vehicle tax revenues. The allocation to roads is 20% of the total revenue and of this amount there is 90% budgeted for construction presented in the capital mod package and this is for the 10% administration portion.
- 8. MVT Local Law Enforcement 1054100 General Fund-Vehicle Tax: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$38,988 related to the 2013 allocation of Motor Vehicle Tax Revenue and balancing of previously estimated final carryover. The new total for this budget is now \$328,988 consisting of \$36,719 carryover and \$290,269 current allocation from 2013 vehicle tax revenues. The current allocation for Law Enforcements is 20% of the "net" revenues. For this calculation, "net" revenues are after tag office expenditures and after allocation to schools and roads.
- 9. <u>Meth & Suicide Prevention 3324040 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$70,558 for carryover reconciliation. The new total for this budget is now \$184,198.

Summary:

After reviewing the submission of Mod #5 by administration, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any concerns related to their respective carryover estimates. If I can provide any further information, please do not hesitate to contact me.
