AN ACT AMENDING TITLE 19 “COUNCIL”, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

Section 1. Title and Codification

This act shall be known as the technical amendments to the Rules of the Tribal Council and codified as Title 19 “COUNCIL” Chapter 1, Section 5 of the Cherokee Nation Code Annotated.

To amend and modernize the Rules of Procedure for the Tribal Council

Section 4. Substantive Provisions

CHAPTER 1

GENERAL PROVISIONS

§ 5 Publication of Council minutes

The approved minutes of each Council meeting, Executive Session excepted, will be published for public viewing on the Legislative Research Center website ~~in the Cherokee Phoenix in their entirety~~ on a regular monthly basis.

Section 5. Provisions as Cumulative

The provisions of this act shall be cumulative to existing law.

Section 6. Severability

The provisions of this act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the Court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this act.


Section 7. Effective Date/Emergency Declared

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and approval.


Section 8. Self-Help Contributions

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.


