

An Act

LEGISLATIVE ACT 16-08

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #37-07 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008 – Mod. 10; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as “An Act Amending Legislative Act #37-07 Authorizing the Comprehensive Budget for Fiscal Year 2008 – Mod. 10”.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the “Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2008” or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$1,554,085 for a total budget authority of \$481,175,375. The following items are identified as estimated General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #37-07 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This amendment changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by a net increase of \$1,554,085 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of \$155,000 related to renovation efforts at the Markoma Gymnasium and special air conditioner funding.
- B. An increase in the **Indirect Cost Pool** budget authority of \$13,983 related to the TERO office; offset by an increase in the IDC recovery resulting in \$0 net impact to available funds.

- C. An increase in the **Enterprise Fund** budget authority of **\$202,216** to authorize the reserve for bad debts on several tribal loan funds.
- D. An increase in the **IHS-Self Governance T.E.H. Fund** budget authority of **\$1,422,000** related to several environmental health water and sanitation projects.
- E. A net decrease in the **NAHASDA Fund** budget authority of **<\$225,131>** with the decrease primarily related to the Modernization funds from the 2007 Indian Housing Plan, slightly offset by an increase in the Coordination funds out of the 2008 Indian Housing Plan.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

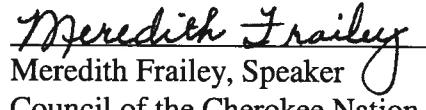
SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

A. JULY - GRANTS RECEIVED (REPORTING ONLY):

B. MOD – 10 (13 budgets) Net Increase in budget authority - \$1,563,068:

General Fund: (Increase - \$150,000)

(1): Building/Structure/Prop. Maintenance: Requesting an increase of \$150,000 to complete the renovation efforts at the Markoma Gymnasium. This request is partially funded by the General Fund (\$100,000) and the remaining amount by a remediation escrow account (\$50,000).

Indirect Cost Pool: (Increase - \$13,983)

(2): T.E.R.O. Procurement: Requesting a slight increase of \$13,983 in this budget to offset a minor increase to staff and related expenses. **Note: The budget request should also include an offsetting increase to the IDC Recovery budget to actually fund the increase (au: 2040000).**

Enterprise Fund: (Increase - \$202,216)

(3 thru 10): Several Economic Development loan programs are requesting budget increases to cover each loan funds respective bad debt reserves. These uncollectible reserves have varying rates and obviously vary in their respective past experiences with bad debts. The loan funds and bad debt rates are as follows:

I.H.S. – Self Governance – T.E.H.: (Increase - \$1,422,000)

(11): Environmental Health (EHS) Projects: Requesting spending authority of an additional \$1,422,000 bringing the total current year funding to \$4,066,000 combined with \$2,755,579 prior year carryover funds, for total budget revenue of slightly over \$6.8 million. This increase is related to the following water & sanitation projects:

NAHASDA Fund: (Net Decrease - <\$225,131>)

(12): Modernization ('07): Requesting a decrease in anticipated spending in the current year from the 2007 Indian Housing Plan for Modernization of <\$291,950>. This decrease is due to an anticipation of approximately \$300,000 remaining unspent by 9/30/08.

(13): Coordination ('08): Requesting \$66,819 of spending authority from the 2008 Indian Housing Plan to cover salaries and fringe benefits for 8 employees until the end of the fiscal year.

C. COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE, LAW ENFORCEMENT & CEMETERIES FUNDS:

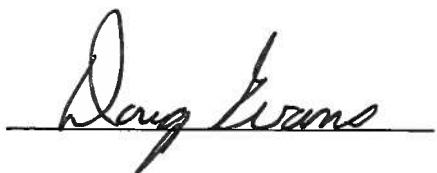
