
BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

§10-5-41. Requests for absentee ballots generally


A registered voter of the Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma who swears or affirms that he or she will be unable to vote in person may make a written request to the chairman of the Tribal Election Committee for an absentee ballot. The request must contain the following information:

- (1) Name.
- (2) Date of birth.
- (3) Address.
- (4) Voter registration number.
- (5) Dawes Commission roll number.
- (6) Signature of witness.
- (7) Address of witness.
