### REPORTS:

1. Claremore Service Unit - George Valliere

*Ms. Kathy Smith reported in the absence of Mr. Valliere. She provided a brief update from the report provided. Councilor Walkingstick inquired if they have contract health funds for dental. Councilor Buzzard inquired if they are looking for bids for the orthopedic contract in Tulsa or Oklahoma City.*

2. Cherokee Nation Health Services - Connie Davis

*Dr. Roger Montgomery reported in the absence of Ms. Davis. He announced Ms. Davis, Dr. Grim and Mr. Hail are visiting the new health facility at Eastern Band of the Cherokees. He also announced he would be stepping down at the end of this week and introduced the interim Medical Director will be Dr. James Stallcup. Dr. Montgomery gave a brief overview of the report provided. He requested a few moments following questions from the standard report to allow Dr. Gahn to provide a mortality report. Councilor Taylor inquired about the program where Walgreens*

*provides prescription drugs to our Native Americans that are not available at our clinics. Councilor Crittenden inquired about a transport service for patients to Oklahoma City. He also inquired about a patient being referred out to an outside specialist and that doctor suggested a treatment that isn't covered by us. Councilor Walkingstick gave appreciation to Dr. Montgomery for his service. Councilor Warner requested an update on the pain management issues. Councilor Buzzard inquired about a behavioral specialist in Jay and also a patient service advocate. He also inquired about the 99 patients who weren't referred out for contract health. Councilor Buzzard inquired about the gardens within the Healthy Nations program as to if they could be raised beds to allow easier access to the elderly. He voiced a complaint about an elder being asked to leave an area following an open house while looking at pictures. Several other Councilors gave appreciation to Dr. Montgomery for his service to the Cherokee people.*
