1. Talking Leaves Job Corp/Career Services/Voc. Ed - Diane Kelley

Ms. Brenda Fitzgerald reported in the absence of Ms. Kelley. She reported all of the Vocational Training Program funds have been obligated for the remainder of this fiscal year. She offered to answer questions from the reports provided. Councilor Hoskin Jr. inquired how much funding would be needed. Councilor Glory-Jordan requested this be an agenda item on the November Executive & Finance committee meeting for discussion. Councilor Cowan Watts requested a report of actuals for the TERO fees.

2. Executive Director's Report - Dr. Neil Morton

Dr. Morton provided a handout containing information on competitive grant funding, cost at Haskell Indian Nations University, Cherokee Nation College Resources

Scholarship policies, and the 2011-2012 A-F Report Card for those schools within the Cherokee Nation boundaries. Dr. Morton offered to bring back a proposal in December of suggested changes to the competitive grant program and the A-F Report Card issues. Councilor Hoskin Jr. inquired about the need for a budget modification. Councilor Cowan Watts requested details of the program in regard to funding, the number assisted, and if technical assistance has been provided to the schools applying. Councilor Glory-Jordan requested an agenda item on the November Executive & Finance Committee for discussion on the MVT competitive grant funds.

#### 3. Head Start - Verna Thompson

Chairman Byrd gave appreciation to Ms. Thompson and her staff for Thanksgiving lunch and the warm hospitality. Ms. Thompson offered to answer questions from the written report.
