CALL TO ORDER

Chair Lay called the meeting to order at 2:08 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Baker moved to approve the December 15, 2014 regular session minutes as submitted. Councilor Snell seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

Human Services Department - Marsha Lamb

Ms. Barbara Foreman reported for Ms. Lamb. Councilor Keener requested clarification on the child support numbers in the report. He requested an overview of the process for assistance with utilities. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired about the Rogers County Elder Advocate. Councilor Snell inquired if there are still wood stoves available.

2. Community Services - Ron Qualls

Mr. Qualls announced they have completed 120 rehabs. Councilor Walkingstick inquired about the number of rehabs currently pending. Councilor Thornton requested the report provided for rehabs be broken down by district rather than county. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired about the difference between rehab and

replacement. Mr. David Pruitt gave an update on the timeline for the rehabs. Councilor Fullbright inquired if a home is demolished when they are given a replacement if they are provided somewhere to stay during the process. Councilor Glory Jordan requested they come back to the Council with a plan and recommendations to address the back log for rehabs.

3. Housing Services - Gary Cooper

Chair Lay announced Mr. Cooper is currently in DC trying to secure additional housing funds.

4. Roads & Transportation - Michael Lynn

Mr. Lynn gave an update on the current projects. Councilor Buzzard inquired about the bridge funding being reduced from \$15,000 to \$7,500 per Councilor. He requested it be put back at \$15,000.
