LEGISLATIVE ACT 21-14

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #21-13 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 – Mod. 11a; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #21-13 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2014 – Mod. 11a".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2014" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by § 4,680,216 for a total budget authority of § 618,411,772. The following items are identified as components of such change:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #21-13 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of $\S 1,755,594$ to wit:

- A. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of \$ 120,031.
- B. An increase in the IHS-Self Governance Health budget authority of \$ 1,485,563.
- C. An increase in the NAHASDA budget authority of \$ 150,000.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

B. MOD #11a Request - (11 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$1,755,594

1. <u>Charitable Donations – 1010042 – General Fund:</u> Modification requesting no change in expenditure authorization. The request is only a project name change for Council District 3.

- **Added after original mailing** <u>Tribal Nursing Program 1010219 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$100,000 to help fund the Cherokee Day Training Program in item 6.
- 3. **Revised after original mailing** <u>Cash Match for Grants 1010315 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$329,500 to fund the Election Commission for \$184,500 and Cherokee Day Training Program for \$145,000. Note the reduction is reported in the Appropriated For Cash Match reconciliation above in the Grant Reporting section. The revised total budget is now \$1,970,572.
- 4. <u>Tribal Election Commission 1010360 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$184,500 for capital purchases of equipment. The funds are made available by the reduction in Cash Match for Grants. The total in this budget is now of \$954,955.
- 5. **Added after original mailing** <u>Tribal Summer Youth 1010533 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$100,000 to help fund the increase in Cherokee Day Training Program.
- 6. **Added after original mailing** Cherokee Day Training Program 1010555 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$345,000. Funding is provided by decreases in items 2, 3, and 5.
- 7. <u>Cherokee Nation Water Plan 3223070 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$21,178 that should have been budgeted in the Water Planning Grant in item 5. The remaining \$310,000 in this budget is from general DOI SG carryover.
- 8. <u>Water Planning Grant 3225000 DOI Self Governance:</u> New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$141,209 for additional funding and the \$21,178 from item 4. This budget is for non-recurring funding awarded to us specifically for water planning.
- 9. <u>SANE 3324050 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$256,596 from carryover reconciliation. The total for this budget is now \$493,084. [Domestic Violence SANE (Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner)]
- 10. <u>Contract Health Service 3324200 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$1,228,667 from an increase in funds awarded related to compacting Claremore CHS effective June 1, 2014. New budget total is \$23,093,891.
- 11. **Added after original mailing** <u>Transitional Emergency Housing 3566060 NAHASDA:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$150,000 for additional client services from available NAHASDA funds. New budget total is \$1,338,522.
