1. 24-002 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DWIGHT BIRDWELL AS MEMBER OF THE CHEROKEE NATION GAMING COMMISSION

Councilor Easley moved to approve. Councilor Callison seconded the motion. The motion carried with Councilors Shotpouch, Deere, Callison, Tehee, Poindexter, Coates, Blackfox-Qualls, Hall and Dobbins requesting to be added as sponsors.

2. 24-003 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE NOMINATION OF JANICE PURCELL TO THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE CHEROKEE NATION

3. 24-004 AN ACT AMENDING TITLE 20 OF THE CHEROKEE NATION CODE ANNOTATED

Councilor Tehee made a motion to approve. Councilor Dobbins seconded the motion. The motion carried with Councilors Kidwell, Callison and Deere requesting to be added as sponsors.

4. 24-005 THE DURBIN FEELING LANGUAGE PRESERVATION ACT - 2024 PERMENANT
