WHEREAS, there are many individuals in need of vocational education in order to enter jobs and become self-sufficient:

WHEREAS, Career Services has both the expertise and experience to develop and operate a high quality, successful program and desires to continue providing these services.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION, that the Council hereby authorizes Career Services to develop and submit a grant application to the Department of Education for a Native American Career and Technical Education Program.
